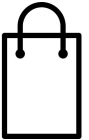

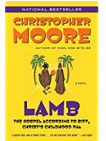

As you may have already heard, Jasmine has been accepted into the ELCA's "Young Adults in Global Mission" Program (YAGM), and has been assigned to the United Kingdom. She will be gone August 2017 to August 2018. It costs about \$15,000 to send each young adult participating in this program, and each person is expected to raise at least \$5,000 of that cost. The Endowment Fund has already agreed to help with part of those funds. If you would like to help Jasmine raise the rest, join in one or more of the upcoming fundraisers: Chloe has a quilt that she's raffling off; there will be an Ice Cream Social here at 2:00 on June 11th; and the VFW is holding a dinner and silent auction on July 22nd.
